Description	Homemade or commercially manufactured face coverings that are washable and help contain wearer's respiratory emissions.	Commercially manufactured masks that help contain wearer's respiratory emissions.	FDA-approved masks to protect the wearer from large droplets and splashes; helps contains wearer's respiratory emissions	Provides effective respiratory protection from airborne particles and aerosols; helps contain wearer's respiratory emissions when no valve is present.
Intended use	<p>Required for all individuals on University property. Refer to policy for specific details. A face covering is not required when working alone in an office but is required when in the presence of others.</p> <p>Cloth face coverings may be unsuitable for some work activities involving certain hazards or materials; use disposable masks instead. Contact the University's Environmental Health & Safety for assistance.</p> <p>Replace disposable face covering at least daily, or sooner if it gets wet or dirty.</p>		<p>These masks are usually reserved for healthcare workers and other approved areas with task-specific hazards determined by EHS. When staff are required to wear these masks for protection, they are considered Personal Protective Equipment and the use is subject to regulation by the Occupational Safety & Health Administration.</p>
